# Year 2007 North American Daylight Savings Time Supplements

## 1 Product Description

The rules for switching to and from US Daylight Saving Time were changed as part of the US Energy Policy Act of 2005. These rule changes are due to come into effect in 2007. Beginning in 2007 Daylight Saving Time (DST) will start at 2am (local time) on the second Sunday of March (instead of the current rule of the first Sunday of April) and end at 2am on the first Sunday of November (instead of the current rule of the last Sunday in October).

This rule change will affect all US and Canadian Time Zones that implement DST. These new rules are going to require changes to your Operating Systems so that the systems continue to function properly past these dates. Potentially some of your applications will need to be updated to accommodate this adjustment as well.

For all its currently supported operating system releases, SCO is providing supplements which implement these changes at no charge and which can be installed immediately. Installing the supplements will not impact the current rules which will adjust for the time change this October 29<sup>th</sup>.
